SPECIALTY SUMMARY

Pilots mobility aircraft and commands crews to accomplish tanker, airlift, training, and other missions.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION FACTORS:

- Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender, or national origin.
- Applicants are subject to review by the FSS to ensure mandatory requirements are met, as outlined in applicable regulations
- Pen/ink changes to any source document, i.e. Report on Individual Personnel (RIP), evaluations, etc. could result in disapproval
- It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF RIP is accurate/in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying duty history, AFSC, service dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND REMINDERS:

- Must be a U.S. Citizen capable of obtaining a Top Secret security clearance.
- Possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited college (or be graduating by Spring of 2022)
- You must not be over the age of 31 on 01 October 2021.
- Vision Requirements:
 - The vision requirement is no worse than a refraction error greater than +2.00 or -3.00. If you have had LASIK/PRK surgery you may be eligible to apply after 6 months have passed since your surgery.
- The height requirement is between 64 inches and 77 inches tall.
- Must have taken and received the results from the following tests:
 - Air Force Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT).
 - Minimum scores: Pilot 25, Verbal 15, Quantitative 10
 - To schedule the AFOQT, contact the Force Development office at the 128th Air Refueling Wing at (414) 944-8436 or the Recruiting office at the 128th Air Refueling Wing at (414) 944-8570.
 - Test of Basic Aviation Skills (TBAS).
 - To schedule a TBAS test go to <https://access.afpc.af.mil/pcsmdmz/index.html> or call SMSgt Galik, (414) 944-8436. Once AFOQT and TBAS is complete you will be able to access the PCSM score.
- The hiring board will take place in November 2021. Packets are due 30 June 2021. Selected applicants can expect to attend pilot training in Fiscal Year 2022 (Oct 2022 - Sep 2023). Training may start earlier or later due to unforeseen circumstances.
- If selected as a candidate for undergraduate flying training, you will be required to establish a permanent residence within 75 miles of General Mitchell Air National Guard Base (Milwaukee, WI) upon satisfactory completion of pilot training.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plans and prepares for mission. Reviews mission tasking, intelligence, and weather information. Supervises mission planning, preparation, filing a flight plan, and crew briefing. Ensures aircraft is preflighted, inspected, loaded, equipped and manned for mission.
- Pilots aircraft and commands crew. Operates aircraft controls and equipment. Performs, supervises, or directs navigation, in-flight refueling, and cargo and passenger delivery.
- Conducts or supervises training of crewmembers. Ensures operational readiness of crew by conducting or supervising mission specific training.
- Develops plans and policies, monitors operations, and advises commanders. Assists commanders and performs staff functions related to this specialty.
